### SCHEDULING AN ARTIST

1. Please consider the following when scheduling an artist for an in-school activity:
  - **DATE AND TIME OF VISIT.** Residency artists are only available during the dates specified above. Residency activities will not be scheduled before 9 a.m.
  - **SESSION LENGTH.** Clinics, workshops and master classes are scheduled for two hour blocks while in-school performances are scheduled for one hour blocks. While each session may not take the full time, activities will not exceed the outlined times.
  - **YOUR SCHOOL'S RESOURCES.** For in-school performances, you must make sure that the performance space has available a tuned acoustic piano and a basic PA system that delivers clear, undistorted sound. The piano must be playable and have been tuned one day prior to the performance. A keyboard is not an acceptable alternative. **THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS.**
