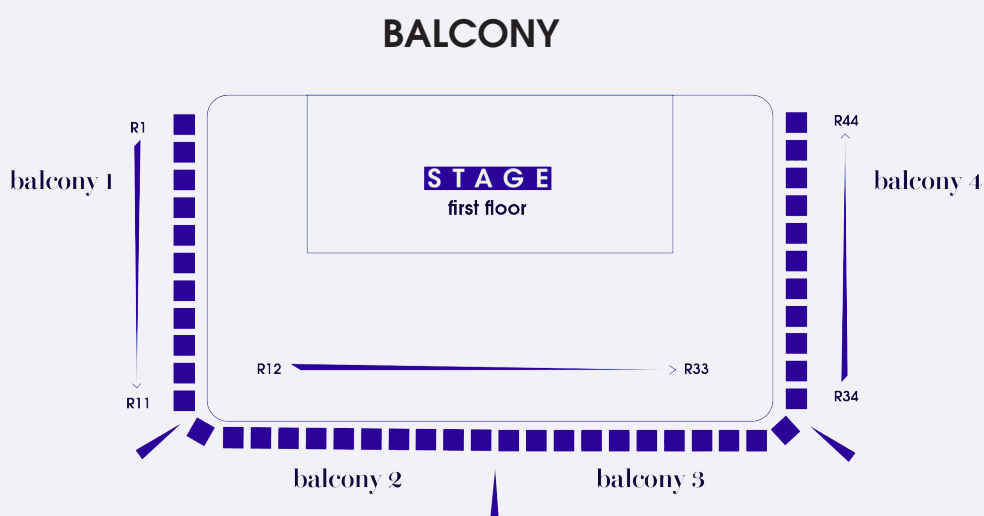

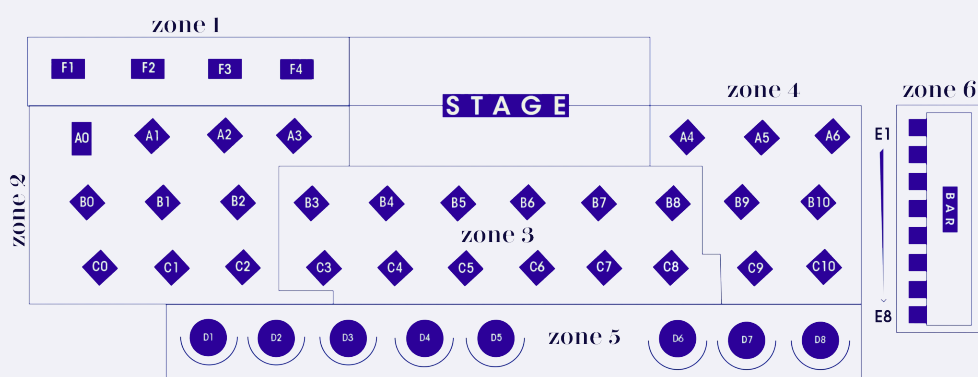
Seating Chart
